Buying New Seats

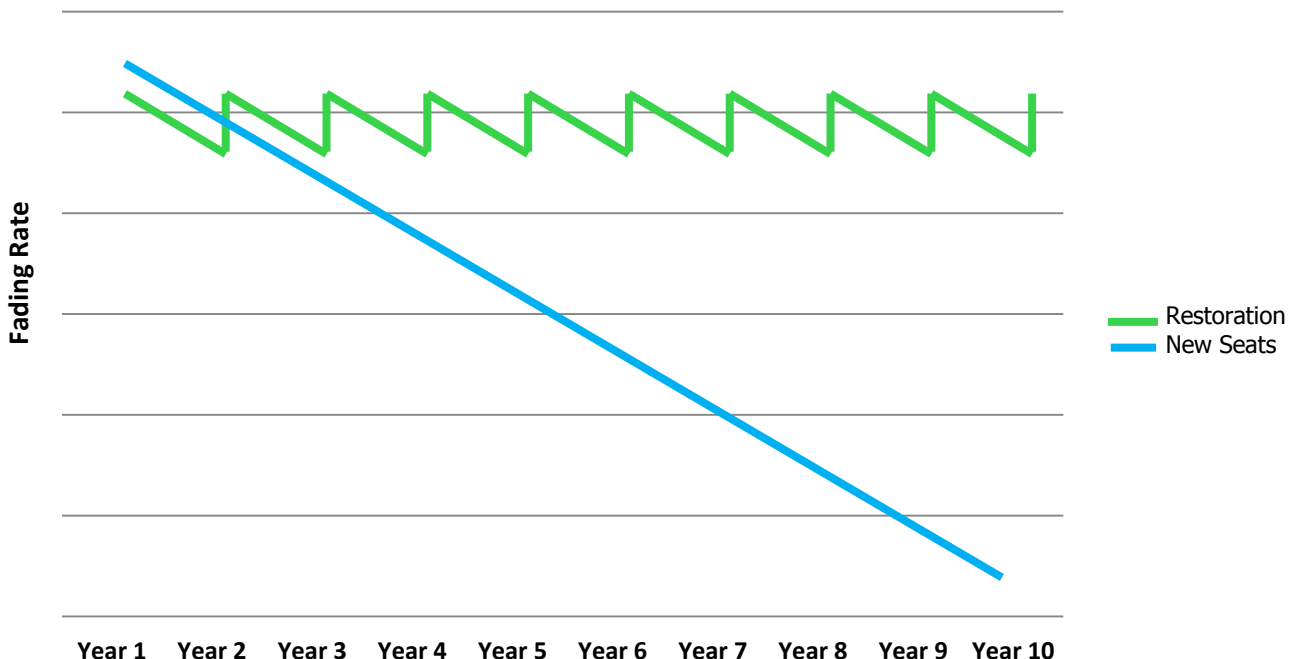
There can be hidden costs of buying new seats, here are some questions to consider;

- How much will replacement new seats cost per seat?
- How much extra will it cost to pay for de-installation and re-installation?
- How much extra will it cost to dispose of the old seats?
- How long will it take to order and install new seats?
- Can current frames and mounting systems be used for new seats?
- How long will the stadium have to close for during installation?
- What will be the "cost of money" if borrowing to buy new seats?
- What is the environmental impact of buying new seats?
- What state will the new seats be in after 10 years?
